

Lecture on "Viewing different parts of a scientific paper by an editor/reviewer - Conditions for accepting a paper for publication"

Associate Professor Dr. Dragan Pamučar, Faculty of Organizational Sciences, University of Belgrade, Serbia

The lecture will cover the following topics:

1. How to write a scientific paper and the content of a scientific paper;
2. Documentation necessary for submitting a paper to a scientific journal;
3. Selection of a journal for the publication of the work;
4. Checking the quality of the work by the editor;
5. Unethical activities;
6. Checking the quality of the work by independent reviewers;
7. How to revise a paper after peer review.

Dr. Dragan Pamučar is an associate professor at the Faculty of Organizational Sciences, University of Belgrade. His research interests are related to the areas: artificial intelligence, mathematical models for decision-making, neuro-fuzzy systems, fuzzy sets, rough sets, neutrosophic theory, etc. Dr. Pamučar has published five books and over 220 scientific papers in SCI indexed journals. Also, Dr. Pamučar is a guest editor in more than 40 SCI indexed journals, including Applied Soft Computing, Sustainable Energy Technologies and Assessments, Mathematical Problems in Engineering, Computer Systems Science and Engineering, Intelligent Automation & Soft Computing, IEEE Transactions on Fuzzy Systems, etc. He is a member of the editorial boards of numerous international scientific SCI indexed journals and scientific conferences.

In 2022, Stanford University ranked Dr. Dragan Pamučar in the 2% most influential scientists in the world in the field of Artificial Intelligence and Soft Computing. In 2022, Dr. Dragan Pamučar is on the list of 1% of the most cited scientists (Highly Cited Researchers).
