

Short Bio Dr. Suzana Brown

Professor Brown studies how modern telecommunications influence business models and contribute to economic development, using real-time data to shorten the decision cycle and provide evidence-based models for policymakers. She is an Associate Professor in the Department of Technology and Society, College of Engineering and Applied Sciences at the State University of New York (SUNY), Korea. She holds a Ph.D. from the Interdisciplinary Telecommunications program at the University of Colorado Boulder. Before SUNY Korea, Suzana Brown worked at Carnegie Mellon University in Rwanda as a scholar in residence.

RESEARCH FIELDS:

Professor Brown's interdisciplinary research has two focal points: 1) Health and mobile technology, Internet of things, Humanitarian use of technology for the vulnerable population, and Assistive technology; 2) Entrepreneurship and Information Technologies for Development (ICT4D).
